The Diving Club membership fee is calculated to include a payment towards club costs and SASA North District Registration; both payments are paid to ADC and renewed in March of each year. SASA Diver membership: £55

SASA Non-Diver membership: £13 (parents, coaches and volunteers who wish to help/get involved with the club)
